CHURCH ADVICE AND REOPENING ARRANGEMENTS

It is my pleasure to write to you all, and to advise you that, subject to any further lockdown advice that we might receive from the Scottish Government on 23rd March, it has been agreed that we can reopen our Church for Sunday Worship.

This letter is to advise you that we plan to open our Church for Sunday Worship on 28th March and 4th April, at 10am and fortnightly thereafter on a temporary basis from 11th April at 10.30am. This is due to Pulpit supply. I invite you all to join with us.

Related to this, it is important for us to be aware that as a result of the Covid-19 restrictions, and to ensure your safety, we will have a limited capacity of 50 seats available in our Church. Strict management arrangements will be in place for accessing and leaving our Church services.

We are required as a result of the above to initiate a seating booking arrangement together with Test and Protect recording arrangements when entering our Church.

It is important, therefore, that you contact us to book your seat in advance of the Service. If you do not book in advance, and we have reached our legal capacity of 50, then you will not be allowed in the building.

To ensure the 2 metre safe distancing, the welcoming team will assist with the movement of congregation members both before and at the close of the service. The advice on this will be available on notices within the Church building and in announcements before and after our Church service.

I would appreciate very much your support and tolerance with the above advice and I look forward to sharing our Worship with you in the coming weeks ahead.
